1873 Susan B. Anthony is fined \$100 USD for attempting to vote in the 1872 presidential election.

1815 Napoleon suffers a shattering defeat at the Battle of Waterloo. The battle was Napoleon's last. The French Emperor was exiled to Saint Helena where he died six years later. "To meet one's Waterloo" is still a figure of speech today indicating total defeat.

1940 A speech by Charles de Gaulle sparks the French Resistance to German occupation after Germany declares more than half of the country an occupied zone. On August 25, French and Allied troops liberated Paris.

1948 The LP record is introduced. It allowed for a total playing time of 20 minutes per side.

Wind chimes originated in China, where it was believed they warded off negative energy and increased the flow of 'CHI' (positive energy) in their surroundings.


Wind chimes are played by the breeze and produce melodious sounds, sometimes tinkling, sometimes sharp, depending on the size and types of materials used.
